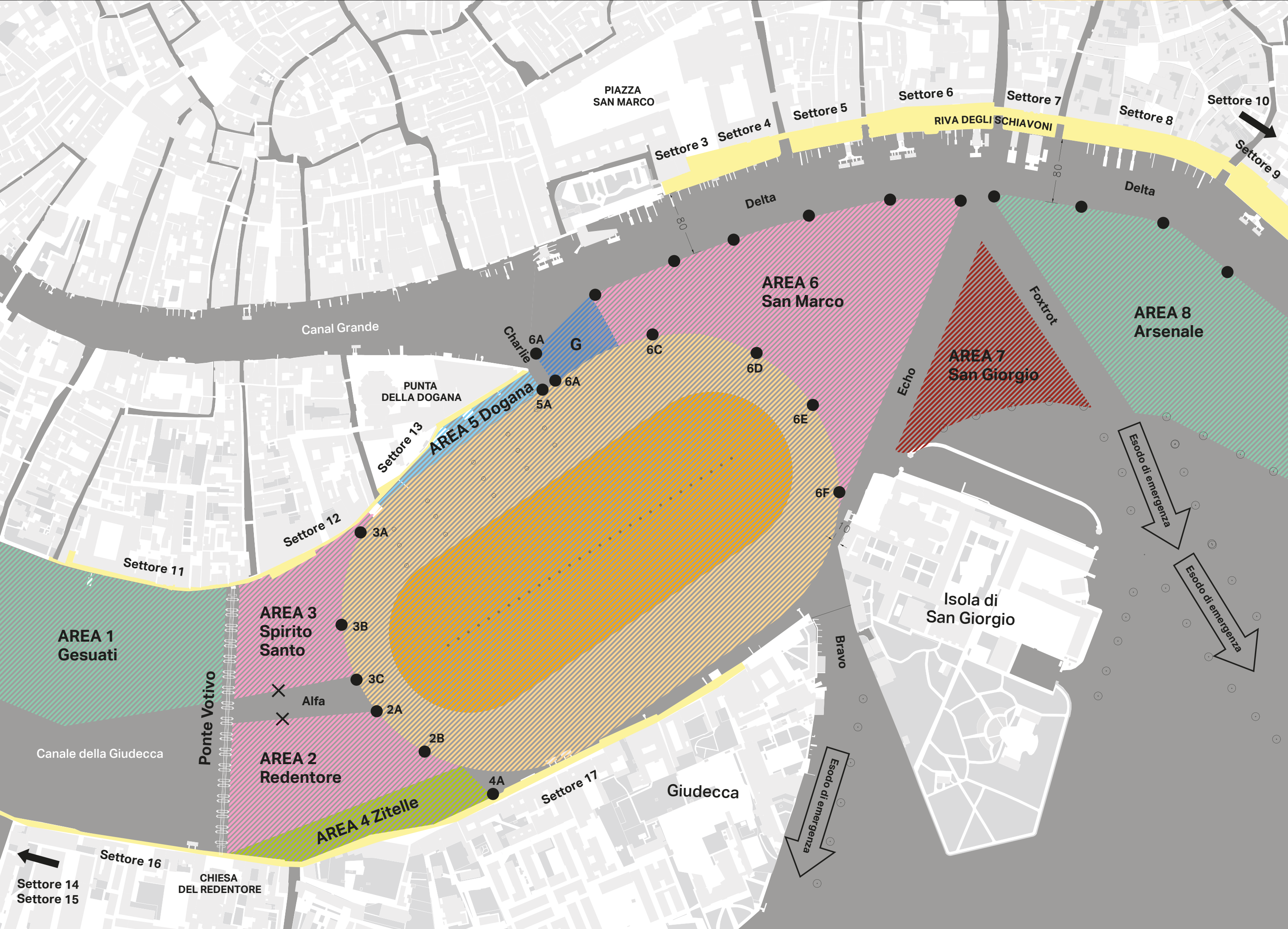

Mooring areas for boats

MOORING AREAS FOR BOATS

The St. Mark's Bay area is divided into different mooring areas for different types of boat. This allows everyone to enjoy a perfect view of the firework display and guarantees safe access to traditional Venetian vessels (see map key).



AREA 1 - Gesuati

West side of the Votive Bridge: pleasure boats, maritime navigation boats, fishing boats, people transport boats and all other boats with a tonnage of more than 10 tons (gross weight) or having more than one deck. Boats will leave the area towards Lido through the channels on the other side of Giudecca Island, Ghebo dei Cani and Orfanello channels.



AREA 2 - Redentore AREA 3 - Spirito Santo AREA 6 - San Marco

Typical local boats, pleasure boats and "mototopi" boats. All these boats must be less than 11 meters long and the board must be less than 100cm high, and with no superstructures.



AREA 7 - San Giorgio

Water Taxi.



AREA 4 - Zitelle

Fondamenta delle Zitelle: sailing boats, max 15 metres long, must moor with the poop.



AREA 5 - Dogana

Area in front of Magazzini del Sale (Ex Dogana - south side): traditional rowing boats, with outboard motors max 9,9 HP.



AREA 8 - Arsenale

East side of the line Rio del Vin - Canale dell'Orfano: pleasure boats, maritime navigation boats, fishing boats, people transport boats and all other boats with a tonnage of more than 10 tons (gross weight) or having more than one deck.



AREA G

Gondolas.



Area close to the fireworks pontoons:

in this area it is forbidden to boats to transit and stop.



Area of the firework display: in this area it is forbidden to boats cannot to stop or moor, but they are allowed to transit at a reduced speed until 9.00 pm.

Transit from the island of San Giorgio Maggiore and the island of Giudecca is forbidden from 5.00 pm to the end of the firework display.

IT IS FORBIDDEN TO MOOR TO THE VOTIVE BRIDGE SAFETY WATER LINE

SAFETY WATER LINE

It is forbidden to stop, to drop anchor and to sail with any kind of boat after 10.45 pm in the following safety water lanes, that must be left free for police and rescue boats:

Alfa

passage under the votive bridge - Giudecca Channel - firework pontoons.

Bravo

passage between San Giorgio island and

Giudecca, closed with floating barriers from 5.00pm to the end of the firework display.

Charlie

passage between Punta della Dogana and the Gondolas area.

Delta

passage connecting the Grand Canal and St. Mark's Basin, facing Molo di San Marco, Riva degli Schiavoni, Riva della Ca' di Dio and Riva di San Biasio/Sette Martiri.

Echo

passage between the areas nr. 6 (San Marco) and nr. 7 (San Giorgio), from the island of San Giorgio to Rio dei Greci.

Foxtrot

passage between the areas nr. 7 (San Giorgio) and nr. 8 (Arsenale), connecting Canale dell'Orfanello with Rio dei Greci.
